

# CAMPING REGULATIONS 2019

Booty Rave Festival is a party, but not without a few house rules. These are necessary to ensure everything runs smoothly. So take note! If the house rules are not complied with, you will be denied access to the festival site and camping site. In the event of violation of the law, the police will be notified. Remember that the organisation always has the last word.

By the purchase of an admission ticket, you agree with the house rules and take the following into account:

## **Entry to the festival site and campsite of Booty Rave Festival:**

Every visitor must be in possession of a valid entrance ticket / wristband. As camper on the campsite of our festival, you must also be in possession of a valid admission ticket / wristband. Camping outside the designated campsite zone is prohibited and will be reported to the relevant authorities. As a visitor you can be searched for prohibited items. In case of refusal, access to the festival site or the campsite can be denied.

## **Opening hours**

The campsite opens its doors on Friday the 6th September 2019 at 16:00 and closes on Sunday the 8th September 2019 at 12:00 (midday). On Friday the festival site is open between 20:00 and 03:00. On Saturday the site is open between 14:00 and 03:00.

## **Car, Mobile home, caravan,..**

Vehicles are not allowed on the campsite. There is parking near the festival for both cars and bicycles. The parking is not a campsite, camping is therefore prohibited. People who camp in the parking lot will be asked to leave the car park immediately.

## **Safety**

If you are caught stealing, being violent, committing arson, vandalism or are in possession of drugs, the police will be informed immediately. Additionally, you will be immediately denied access to the festival site and campsite.

## **Theft**

We supervise both the festival terrain and the campsite. Yet it is impossible to pay attention to everyone's belongings. We advise that you leave your valuables, but if you do bring them, do not leave them unattended. The organisation can not be held responsible for loss or theft of personal items.

## **Glass and Weapons**

Glass and weapons are forbidden on the campsite and the festival terrain. Cans and plastic bottles are allowed. It is forbidden to catapult any object (not limited to glass and weapons) in the air. If you do, total access to the event will immediately be denied. In this case, the organisation also lodges a complaint with the relevant authorities.

## **Fire**

In the context of fire prevention it is forbidden to make fire at all times. With so many tents close together, fire is extremely dangerous. This means: no fire in the open air. No campfires, barbecues, torches, candles or fireworks. Setting your tent on fire after the festival is strictly forbidden! Keep the fire escapes and emergency exits free for your own safety. If you do not comply with these rules, your tent will be removed.

Camping gas (blue buses) are allowed up to **max. 1kg**.

Fire extinguishers are present with the necessary signage.

## **Vandalism**

Vandalism is out of the question. We ask our visitors to respect everyone's property and the environment. It is forbidden to climb fences, toilets, tents, etc. Graffiti is also not allowed. The organisation can not be held responsible for damage to personal items. In case of damage to objects that were already on the site, the cost of the damage will be recovered from the vandal.

## **Dogs and other pets**

Animals are not allowed on the campsite or the festival terrain. We do make an exception for assistance dogs for people with disabilities. Loose animals are caught. The owner of the lost animal will have to pay at least €125 in order to get the animal back. If this does not happen, the animal will be transferred to a kennel. The costs of this must also be paid by the owner of the animal.

## **Noise**

Noise pollution is prohibited. Generators, vuvuzelas and music installations are not allowed on the campsite or the festival site. Think of your festival mates who want to enjoy the music or to relax after a tiring festival day. In case of noise nuisance, you also run the risk of being denied total access.

## Drugs

Drugs, narcotics or items that can be used as drugs are prohibited. If you are caught in possession, the police will be informed immediately and total access to the festival will be denied.

## Trade

Under no circumstances may trade be conducted. It is forbidden to sell food, drinks, drugs or anything else. The people who conduct trade will immediately be removed from the festival site and campsite.

## Waste

The waste mountain from a group of campers is huge! We provide garbage bags in different places. Make use of them! Take your tent and other camping gear home with you too!

## Facilities

The campsite is equipped with toilets, running water and showers. Food & drinks are available at democratic prices.

There are toilets and running water at the festival grounds. In addition, there are food stands for which you can purchase food tickets on the festival site. The drinks on the festival site are included in the ticket price.

First Aid is present.

## Lost and Found

Lost objects are collected by the organisation after the festival. If you find an object that is not yours, you must hand it in to the organisation. The owner can come and collect this with the necessary proof of identification.

One week after the end of the festival, the objects are handed over to the Kasterlee police.
